

Financial Certification

To get a visa and enter the United States, all international students must prove that they will have adequate financial support. Following is an ESTIMATED budget for a single student who is planning to study in the Intensive English Program at The University of Mississippi.

These are estimated based on minimum expenditures and current fees. The student may make choices about living accommodations or other expenses that would influence cost and total more than the amounts listed above. Estimates do not include travel from the home country or in the United States, clothing, entertainment, or miscellaneous expenditures. A student with dependents must budget an additional \$850 per 8 week session for each dependent.

Before we send you an I-20, we must receive at least one of the following:

1. Students who are providing their own financial support must send an official bank statement not more than 6 months old with the official bank seal and signature of a bank officer testifying that they have at least the estimated expenses indicated above in their personal bank or savings account for the total number of sessions they plan to attend.
2. Students who will be sponsored by a friend or family member must have the sponsor complete and sign the Declaration of Sponsor below. The sponsor must provide an official bank statement and signature of a bank officer testifying that they have at least the estimated expenses indicated above in their personal bank or savings account for the total number of sessions the student plans to attend.
3. Students who have official government or agency sponsors should submit the standard sponsorship documents used by them to guarantee financial support.
